



Netviewer Present

General Information

Netviewer Present enables interactive Live-Presentations over the Internet for a desired number of spectators. It is possible to incorporate videos, sound, images, PDF documents and PowerPoint presentations while the moderator's image is broadcast live via Webcam / DV-Cam. Chat options enable a dialogue with or among the spectators. Spectators only need a browser and internet access. Presentations can be recorded and thus made available over a long period of time. Netviewer Present can be integrated into the customer's own website.

This data sheet contains the technical data which needs to be provided for smooth usage of Netviewer Present and describes available features of the application.
